

**AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF  
INCORPORATION**

The undersigned incorporator, in order to form a corporate entity under Kansas Statutes, adopts, amends and restates the following articles of incorporation in accordance with Kansas Statutes Annotated, Chapter 17 – specifically K.S.A. 17-6605. Original Articles were filed 02/07/2011 at 16:56:03 with a Kansas Business Entity Number: 6503536

**ARTICLE I**

**NAME/REGISTERED OFFICE**

The name of this corporation shall be HIGH PLAINS YOUTH HOCKEY ASSOCIATION, located at 1001 1ST AVE, DODGE CITY, KS 67801. Its mailing address shall be HIGH PLAINS YOUTH HOCKEY ASSOCIATION, POST OFFICE BOX 905, DODGE CITY, KS 67801. The registered agent is James R. Johnson, located at 1001 1ST AVE, DODGE CITY, KS 67801.

**ARTICLE II**

**PURPOSE**

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes specifically to promote and teach health, strength and sportsmanship in children ages from 4 to 18 through youth hockey in Southwest Kansas. This shall consist of regular classes and lessons in ice skating, including training for the game of hockey and actual playing of limited games of hockey under affiliation with the national governing body of youth hockey, USA Hockey. To this end, the corporation shall at all times be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is organized under the laws of Kansas. All funds, whether income or principal, and whether acquired by gift or contribution or otherwise, shall be devoted to said purposes. This corporation will not have the authority to issue stock. The conditions of membership are set in ARTICLE V.
